DILUTION DIRECTIONS: This Concentrate must be diluted with petroleum distillate prior to use either as a space or contact spray. Use 1 part concentrate to 29 parts petroleum distillate to make a ready-to-use spray. The resulting spray will contain 0.30% tetramethrin and 0.25% d-phenothrin.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

IN FOGGING EQUIPMENT: Use in a cold aerosol generator or mechanical hand sprayer that produces particles of aerosol size (30 microns or less).

To Kill Gnats, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Close room, warehouse or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense this product as a fine mist. Use a dosage of 1/2 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of room space. Do not remain in treated areas. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Apply as a coarse wet spray to all other areas infested with these insects. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices in floors, walls, and ceiling.

To Kill Firebrats and Sowbugs: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and machinery.
