The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the piperonyl butoxide and pyrethrins REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

CAUTION

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Only for formulation into an insecticide for the following uses: (1) Residential and commercial indoor non-food areas, on domestic animals, pets and non-commercial ornamental plants; (2) Uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or in support of registration; and (3) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

Not for formulation into Wettable Powder formulations unless they are packaged in water soluble bags.

All liquid and RTU products labeled for use on indoor surfaces at residential sites must be formulated to contain no more than 0.5% permethrin active ingredient. Total release foggers labeled for indoor use at residential sites must be formulated to contain no more 0.58% permethrin active ingredient.

Do not exceed an application rate equivalent to 1.25 grams of a.i. per square meter of fabric.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s).

This product is to be used with appropriate solvents, carriers, and in the case of pressurized products, propellants in the manufacture of insecticide sprays.

Warm gently to liquefy and mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of container in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with diluent. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.
