STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

For Control of Wasps and Hornets: Apply after dark when all insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, soaking the nest with the spray. Repeat as necessary for control.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible directly with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants, treat doors, window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for control.
