Precautionary Statements
 Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION
 Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.
INDOORS — To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.
To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants, treat doors, window sills, ant trails and other areas as necessary. Repeat as necessary for control.
To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.
To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Beetle and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages if shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.
To Kill Sowbugs, Earwigs, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. A thorough spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.
OUTDOORS — To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying Moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grass areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at five rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open grass and pastures in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying treated area. Repeat as necessary.
To Protect Ornamental Plants: For the below listed insects infesting Roses, Azalea, Cherry, Amelanchier, Wisteria, Grape, Hibiscus, Plum, Hollyhock, Pussy Willow and Purple Loosetrife. Also for the insects specified below on Evergreens, Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees, Shrubs and Vines. Caution should be taken when spraying new Rose growth since some varieties may exhibit phytotoxicity. Do not spray in hot, windy weather.
 When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill Aphids, Mites, Japanese Beetles, Plant Slugs, Whitefly, Southern Army Worm Larvae, Mexican Bean Beetle Larvae, Cucumber Beetles, Lacebugs, Mealybugs, Measuring Worms.
WHEN SPRAYING KEEP CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.
 For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Avoid contact with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 ft. per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90 F.
 This product may be used outside on porches, patios and in the yard and picnic areas to kill Flies, Mosquito, Gnats and Flying Moths present at the time of treatment. Spray the area liberally. Spray with the breeze allowing the spray to drift into shrubbery and other places where insects harbour. Repeat as necessary.
To Kill Wasps: Spray nests with a generous blast (at least 4-6 seconds) from this unit from a distance of approximately 2 ft. — soaking the nest thoroughly with the spray. To avoid being stung make applications dusk or other times when wasps are not active.
To Kill Sowbugs and Ants: Spray directly as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails. Repeat as necessary for control.
