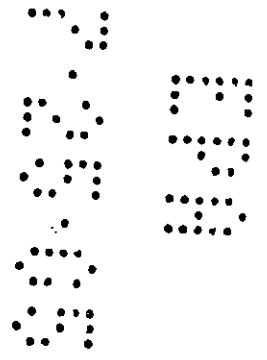

Please find enclosed a Notification per PR Notice 98-10 to correct a typographical error in the ingredient concentration statement of the above-listed product. On all previously stamped labels, the percentage of d-trans allethrin was incorrectly listed as 0.65%; I corrected this to 0.60%. Additionally, I corrected the concentration of Other Ingredients from 96.15% to 96.20%. I enclosed a copy of the current Confidential Statement of Formula for your reference.

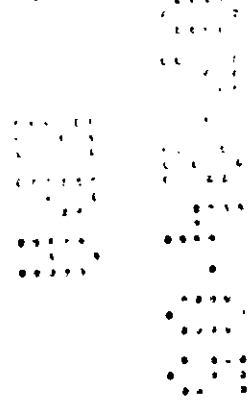

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, and food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage areas (after canning or bottling).

Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

General: This product can be used in mechanical sprayers that produce particles of aerosol size.

Space Spray to Kill Gnats, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Close room and shut off all air conditioning and ventilating equipment. Apply with mechanical or compressed air sprayer or with fogger that gives small particle size. Direct spray towards upper corners of room

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and ceiling. Apply at a rate of 0.5 to 1.0 fluid ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space treated. Vacate room and leave closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Ventilate thoroughly prior to reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

Contact or Surface Spray to Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Apply with a sprayer that will give coarse wet droplets. Force spray into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, areas at base of machinery, behind cabinets, around pipes and openings, along baseboards and other insect harborages. Use one gallon of spray per 1,000 square feet of surface to be treated. For ants, spray trails and all points of entry into building. Spray ant nests directly with a soaking application. In all cases, contact as many insects as possible with spray.

To Kill Black Carpet Beetles and Dermestids: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

To Kill Bedbugs: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards, floorboards and wall cracks and crevices. Allow spray to dry before contacting treated surfaces.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae, Lesser Grain Borers, Rice Weevils and Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried.

To Kill Fleas and Ticks: Remove and destroy animal's old bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely. Direct spray into cracks and crevices. Allow spray to dry and replace clean bedding. Do not spray animals directly. Animals should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL	
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.	
<u>STORAGE:</u> Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.	
<u>PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:</u> Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
