HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part II. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash with soap and warm water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: This product is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which produce particles of aerosol size, such as the LECO or MICRO-GEN.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

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NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

FOR USE IN HOMES, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL AREAS: Space Spray - Undiluted: To kill Gnats, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one-half (0.5) ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Space Spray - Diluted For Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment - to kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes And Small Flying Moths: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 9 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fluid ounces of dilute spray (0.4 gallon) per 25,000 cubic feet of space. Direct fog upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

Contact Spray - Undiluted - To Kill Black Carpet Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae, Rice Weevils and Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog aerosol generator, direct discharge into areas suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Spray until treated surfaces are moist with deposit. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Contact Spray - Undiluted - To Kill Cockroaches: Using an ULV spraying device such as the Eliminator or Actisol unit, inject the aerosol spray directly into cracks and crevices to completely fill wall, equipment, and other small structural void areas. Leave room ventilation or air conditioning equipment on during application. Except in hospitals, as noted above, the room can be reentered immediately after applications are complete.

Contact Spray - Diluted for use with Sprayers that Give Large, Wetting Spray Particles to Kill Cockroaches and Accessible Stages of Granary Insects: Cadelles, Confused Flour Beetles, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Indian Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Rusty Grain Beetles and Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles: Cover or remove exposed food and close room as described above. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part of concentrate plus 9 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harborages using 1 gallon of spray per 1,000 square feet of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary.

NOTE: When using oil as the diluent, an odorless light petroleum hydrocarbon as defined by CFR Title 21, §172.884 should be used for all food area and food related applications. Additionally, when diluted and used according to label directions, this spray will meet specifications for use under USDA meat, poultry, shell egg grading, and egg products inspection programs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and Local procedures.
