Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

**DELETE** Delete the entire second paragraph in the "Precautionary Statements" block that currently reads "Do not use in commercial food processing ... mop closets and storage areas (after canning or bottling)." This information belongs under Directions for Use and requires some modification.

**ADD** The following paragraph at the beginning of the "Directions for Use" block:

"WHERE TO USE: For use in the home and in non-food areas of food processing plants, schools, warehouses, office buildings, theaters, garages, hotels, motels, kennels, and hospitals. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage areas after canning or bottling. Do not use in food areas (i.e. areas where food is received, processed, prepared, stored, or served) of commercial food handling establishments."

EXPAND      Expand the "General" section in the "Directions for Use" block to read:

**"GENERAL:** Apply this product as a crack and crevice or spot treatment with a compressed air sprayer to localized areas where the insects listed below are found. In the home, do not contaminate food or food handling surfaces. Remove all exposed food before treatment. All food handling surfaces and utensils in the home should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use."

Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the above changes prior to releasing your product for shipment. If the above provisions are not complied with the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A copy of your label stamped "accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine, by injection, is antidotal and should be administered only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition have appeared. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. 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It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DILUTION DIRECTIONS:** This concentrate must be diluted with water before use. Dilute 6 parts of concentrate with 94 parts water. Mix well and apply as directed below. DO NOT STORE diluted spray for future use.

**General:** Apply this product as a crack and crevice or spot treatment with a compressed air sprayer to localized areas where the insects listed below are found.

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders:** Force spray into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, areas at base of machinery, behind cabinets, around pipes and openings, along baseboards and other insect harborages. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray trails and all points of entry into building. Spray ant nests directly with a soaking application. In all cases, contact as many insects as possible with spray. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Fleas and Ticks:** Remove and destroy animal's old bedding and apply this spray as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Allow spray to dry and replace clean bedding. Do not spray animals directly. Animals should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Black Carpet Beetles and Dermestids:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Where possible, the bottom of rugs and carpets should be spot sprayed. Apply as a spot application to rugs and carpets in areas such as under furniture, corners of rooms, and areas not subject to foot traffic, as these are where carpet beetle larvae are commonly found. Also spot treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by State and Local authorities.
