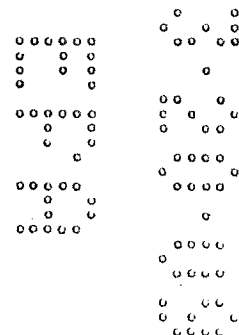

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area under lock and key. Post as pesticide storage area. Keep container closed. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food, pet food, feed, seed, fertilizers and veterinary supplies.
