General: EVERCIDE® Formula 2336 is a ready-to-use formulation which is to be dispensed in CO₂ charged compressed air sprayers. Six (6) to eight (8) ounces of product should be used to treat an average size home or apartment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below.

EVERCIDE® Formula 2336 may also be diluted at the rate of one (1) part of product to six (6) parts oil and used in conventional compressed air sprayers at the rate of one (1) gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet of surface area.
