

Warm to room temperature. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

Triple Rinse as follow for containers of 5 Gallons or less: Empty the remaining contents in to application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ½ full with diluent and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use of disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Triple rinse as follows for containers greater than 5 Gallons: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with diluent. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll in back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 20 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back an d forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents in to application equipment or a mix tank. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rise at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip
