The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- a) Move the statement recommending groomers to wear gloves to the directions for use section of the labeling.
- b) Delete the phrase ".....that may transmit Lyme disease". Although there is data to show that this product kills ticks that may transmit it, it is not a disease of dogs or cats and therefore, is a misleading statement.

Enclosed is a copy of your stamped label "Accepted with Comments". Submit three (3) copies of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Shake EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

To Kill Fleas, Lice, Ticks and Deer Ticks (*Ixodes* spp.): Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 gives control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL:
