Shake EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

To Kill Fleas, Lice, Ticks, and Deer Ticks (*Ixodes* spp.): Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant, or nursing animals.

EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 gives control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks as necessary.
