STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area under lock and key. Post as a pesticide storage area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food, pet food, and veterinary supplies. Place liquid formulations on lower shelves and dry formulations above.

Pesticide Disposa
