Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin." to "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor." and move before the sentence "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." in the Precautionary Statement.
2. Delete "If ingested, call a physician immediately." this is covered in the first aid statements.
3. Add "and other aquatic organisms" to the first sentence under environmental hazards.
