The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Phenothrin and Tetramethrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash utensils before use. Cover exposed food and remove utensils in serving areas.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying, and turn aquarium systems off.

Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS IN PET BEDDING AND PET AREAS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding, sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, local areas of floors, and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also, spray the entire inside surface of doghouses. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to re-enter treated area.
