

Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. To apply to face, spray into hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases.
