Apply sparingly around ears. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands & then put it on the child. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing.
