To repel the listed insects: Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If used on the face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face.

Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and /or clothing. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing.
