**GENERAL:** Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control ants, cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

#### FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Fleas and Ticks:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames; and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

#### FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

**To Kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Dermestids, Earwigs, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks:** Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between elements of construction; between equipment and floors; openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls; equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
