- Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas. Do not apply when food is present. Remove or cover exposed food. Cover all food preparation surfaces and utensils or thoroughly wash before reuse.
- Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
- . Do not enter or allow others to enter treated are until sprays have dried.
- . Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, whether directly or through drift.
- Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff.
- · Do not make applications during rain.
- · All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice and wasp and hornet nest treatments only.
- All outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

For Control of Nests of Wasps, Yellow Jackets, and Hornets: The best time to spray is in the early morning or early evening, when air temperature is cooler and most insects are in the nest and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if it is not windy. Stand a safe distance from the nest, not directly underneath it. Hold container upright at arms length, pointing the actuator at nest and spraying the opening of the nest first. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. Treated insects will fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the treated nest will also be killed. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest. Foliage of desirable plants contacted during spraying should be hosed off with water.

<u>For Control of Ants and Spiders</u>: (Outdoors only) For Ants and Spiders found in areas such as electric service boxes, water meter boxes, telephone boxes, along house foundation, foundation vents, sills and ledges, etc., spray in short bursts to contact pests. Ant trails, runways, and hills should also be sprayed as necessary. Do not spray foliage of desirable plants. If spray does contact foliage, hose off with water.
