Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present.
