The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Esfenvalerate Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for

shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Avoid contamination of food. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not apply this product in patient rooms or in any rooms while occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. Do not apply in institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area where occupants are present.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Application within food and non-food areas of food service and handling establishments including, but not limited to: restaurants, grocery stores, bakeries, food manufacturing and processing establishments, and food warehousing establishments.

Do not use in feed handling establishments or where livestock food is present.

AS A SPACE SPRAY:

To kill Gnats, Hornets, House Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Wasps: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Direct spray first into all cracks and crevices, behind all equipment, appliances, cupboards, or any dark harborage areas, then treat as a space spray directing the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the room. Do not remain in treated area. Keep area closed for at least ½ hour and ventilate thoroughly before reentry. Do not exceed more than one application every fourteen (14) days in food handling establishments.

Spray at the rate of 15-20 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space.

To kill the adult and accessible forms of insect pests* of: stored food (stored in Multi-walled paper bags or in cloth bags) in warehouses, storage rooms and similar locations: Infested stored products should be removed and destroyed, fumigated or treated with other products approved for this use. Keep area closed for at least ½ hour. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Do not repeat application more than once every three days.

*Almond moths, angoumois grain moths, ants, cadelles, cigarette beetles, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, flat grain beetles, grain mites, granary weevils, Indian meal moths, Mediterranean flour moths, red flour beetles, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles and yellow mealworms.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size.

To kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Firebrats, Millipedes, Palmetto Bugs, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Water Bugs: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.

To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces.

To kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.
