The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Add the statement: "This product can not be tank mixed with synergists for use in food areas of food handling establishments."
2. Revise the precautionary statements to reflect recommendations made in PR Notice 2001-1 entitled "First Aid Statements on Pesticide Product Labels."

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
