This [formulation] [brand name] contains two highly effective active ingredients that provide quick knockdown and kill [control] of exposed fleas in carpets, rugs, draperies, upholstery, pet bedding, floor cracks and crevices and cabinets. Controls adult fleas in the carpet. Occasionally adult fleas may be present in treated areas when reintroduced from infested animals.

[MULTICIDE® Pressurized Spray 2594] [brand name] effectively kills listed insects when used as directed. To protect your pet against and to minimize reintroduction of adult fleas from outdoors, use a product registered for use on animals to treat dogs or cats having access to the house, in addition to this carpet treatment.

[As part of a complete flea control program use EPA registered [brand name] outdoor [lawn] [home and garden] spray, [brand name] [pressurized] [Ready-to-Use] [RTU] flea and tick [indoor] [premise] spray.]

## USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on this label
- Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.
- THIS PRODUCT IS INTENDED FOR INDOOR RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY.
- Do not apply this product directly to domestic animals (pets).
- . Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter treated areas until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- Wait two (2) hours after application, and then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.
- Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use
  in serving areas while food is exposed of facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding
  areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover
  dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.

- Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums and ornamental fish ponds before spraying, and turn aquarium systems off prior to application

SHAKE BEFORE USE. For use on carpets and furnishings, turn container upside down and point valve toward surface to be sprayed and apply with an even sweeping motion. [For a General Spray,] hold can upright. Point valve away from face and press button.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS: Prior to application, thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Put vacuum bag into a sack and dispose of in outside trash. Hold can 2-3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Apply uniformly, using a slow sweeping motion, treat entire areas of rugs and carpets. Treat under and around furniture if pets frequently rest in these areas. Always test in an inconspicuous [hidden] area prior to use as some natural and synthetic fibers may be adversely affected by any liquid product. A fine spray applied uniformly is all that is necessary to kill fleas. To kill ticks and other labeled insects, apply directly to pests. Do not allow children or pets to walk on treated surfaces until completely dry.

This application can also be used on upholstered furniture and draperies. Avoid excessively wetting upholstered furniture and draperies and always test product in an inconspicuous [hidden] area prior to use.

FOR USE IN VEHICLES: If flea infested animals are transported in vehicles, use as directed above to kill the infestation.

Use this product as part of a complete flea control program.

To protect your pet against and to minimize reintroduction of adult fleas, use a product registered for use on animals to treat dogs or cats having access to the house, in addition to this carpet treatment. Do not treat pets with this product. Also use a product registered for treatment of the outdoor area used by the pet.

#### IDIRECTED SPRAY1:

COCKROACHES [Smoky Brown Cockroach, Brown Banded Cockroach, Asian Cockroach, German Cockroach, American Cockroach, Australian Cockroach, Oriental Cockroach] Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Crickets, Firebrats, Silverfish, Booklice, Scorpions, Spiders, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Earwigs, Clover Mites, Lice, and Millipedes: Contact as many insects as possible with this spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, around garbage cans, cabinets, along baseboards, door and window frames and floors, around drains, pipes, plumbing, behind bookcases, storage and other utility installation areas hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

EXPOSED STAGES of Flour Beetles, Cadelles, Rice Weevils, Flat Grain Beetles, Cigarette Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Lesser Grain Borers, Merchant Grain Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Grain Weevils, Warehouse Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Grain Mites, Cheese Mites, and Indian Mealworms. Find and dispose of infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry, shelves and drawers, and clean thoroughly. Spray into cracks and crevices, shelves, drawers, cabinets, and other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Place clean paper on shelves and return packages after spray has dried.

CARPET BEETLES [Dermestids (Trogoderma)]: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly, where possible. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, local areas of floors, walls, and baseboards and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

CLOTHES MOTHS and other Flying Moths: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage areas directing the spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. Return clean articles after spray has thoroughly dried.

ANTS, Pharaoh Ants, and Carpenter Ants [Eastern (Western)]: Treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

FOR USE IN PET AREA: Treat pet bedding and other areas where pets rest as these are primary hiding places for fleas and ticks. To reduce infestation, spray around sleeping areas, baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, local areas of floors and other animal resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Also spray the entire inside surface of doghouses. Allow treated areas to dry thoroughly before allowing pets to re-enter. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.

For best results, pets should be treated with a product registered for use on animals to treat dogs or cats having access to the house, in addition to this carpet treatment.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
