By Notification, we are updating the storage and disposal statement per PR-Notice 2004-7. This product is a manufacturing use product that is not diluted prior to use, therefore we have not added detailed rinsing instructions per §156.146. We have however, per Nancy Fitz' recommendation maintained our current instructions to triple rinse the container before disposing of it.
