Dear Ms. Schlekau:

We have reviewed the above referenced submission, in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. The labeling is acceptable with the following comments:

Based on the data submitted, this product is expected to perform efficaciously against Red Imported Fire Ant (RIFA), when at least 6oz is applied to an individual mound using the "delivery chamber". Thus, the addition of RIFA to the label is acceptable provided:

- You submit data indicating greater than 90% reduction in the mean number of treated mounds, with acceptable control mortality for three additional geographically separate areas.
- The "total release" canister bearing the claim for fire ants is no less than 6oz.
- The label bears directions mandating that the applicator use this product in conjunction with the device described in Patent No. 6,688,036 B1 or similar device.

Please make the above stated changes to the product's labeling and submit two copies of the revised final printed label to the Agency. 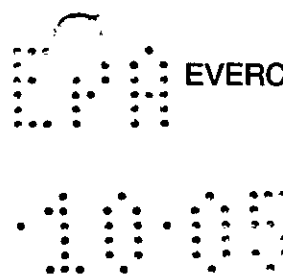

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

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Authorized for use in Federally Inspected Meat, Milk and Poultry Plants.

Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. X 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL Ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Do not apply when food-processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment before application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging (canning, bottling, wrapping, and boxing), preparing, edible waste storage, and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, and syrups). Serving areas are places where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but not excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas include entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present.

This product will kill Ants, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Fleas, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Rice Weevils, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Small Flying Moths, Sowbugs, Spiders and Ticks.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling). Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two (2) hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in (2) two weeks.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

OUTDOOR USE ONLY:

Fire Ant Application: Before placing the Fire Ant Housing over the mound, activate the mound by disturbing the mound with a digging tool (stick, spade, ax, knife, etc.). Quickly place the Fire Ant Housing (bucket, canopy, box) over the mound so that it covers a majority of the ant mound and engage lever mechanism to discharge the aerosol. Back away from Fire Ant Housing while aerosol evacuates and leave undisturbed for 15 minutes. Keep children and pets away until treated area is dry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL:

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
