#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared, processed or stored. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

This product will kill ants, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, mosquitoes, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, small flying moths, sow bugs, spiders (including black widow), and brown dog ticks.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or on table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying if necessary, but no sooner than within 2 weeks.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.
