The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Esfenvalerate and Tetramethrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

**BEFORE YOU FOG:**

In the home do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and ventilation equipment. Put out all flames, pilot lights and other ignition sources. Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance.

Remove pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before activating fogger.

Place a chair, small table or stand in the center of the room to be treated and cover with newspaper

Cover wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area around fogger with newspapers or a drop cloth. Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated.

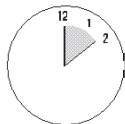
Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

**TO START FOGGING:** Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button down firmly, until it snaps into place. [Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up).] Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

**Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately.** Do not remain in the area during treatment. Keep treated area closed for two (2) hours.

**Do not re-enter for 2 hours.**



**AIRING OUT:** Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required.

EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 6 REPRESENTING "AIR OUT ROOM BEFORE ENTERING"

**To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
