Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The hazards to humans and domestic animals statements should be organized so that routes of exposure of most concern should be listed first. Therefore revise the first part of this section as follows:

"Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Prolonged or frequently repeated xxx etc."
