By Notification, we are updating the storage and disposal statement per PR-Notice 2004-7. This product is a manufacturing use product that is not diluted prior to use, therefore we have not added detailed rinsing instructions per §156.146. We have however, per Nancy Fitz' recommendation maintained our current instructions to triple rinse the container before disposing or offering for reconditioning or recycling. A copy of Nancy's recommendation is enclosed for your convenience.

Enclosed are two (2) copies of the label. One (1) copy has changes highlighted.

This amendment is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156.
