By Notification we are changing the storage and disposal language to comply with the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment". We are also clarifying two marketing claims which are specific to fleas to read as such. There are existing data to support these claims.

Enclosed are 2 copies of the label. One copy has changes highlighted.

Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.



For flea and tick control, thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Put vacuum bag into a sack and dispose of in outside trash. Mop all hard floor surfaces.
