The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

<u>General Comment(s)</u>:

 To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the Agency's guidance "Update on Required Label Language for Indoor Total Release Fogger Products," dated July 6, 2011, now that the pictograms for all total release fogger (TRF) products have been finalized by the Agency, you must include the approved pictograms when you must submit your updated final label in response to this SAL.

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s), top of page 2 of 6:

2. To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the REDs for pyrethrins, esfenvalerate, pyriproxyfen, piperonyl butoxide, and MGK-264 insecticide synergist, you must insert the word "hands" immediately following the word "Wash."

Directions for Use, USE RESTRICTIONS subsection comment(s), bottom of page 3 of 6:

 To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the REDs for pyrethrins, esfenvalerate, pyriproxyfen, piperonyl butoxide, and MGK-264 insecticide synergist, you must revise and CAPITALIZE the 3rd bulleted use restriction to read "THIS PRODUCT IS FOR INDOOR RESIDENTIAL/NON-RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY."

Directions for Use section comment(s), bottom of page 4 of 6:

4. To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the Agency's guidance "Required Label Language for Indoor Total Release Fogger Products," dated March 23, 2010, and "Update on Required Label Language for Indoor Total Release Fogger Products," dated July 6, 2011, within the 2nd sentence of the "TO START FOGGING:" subsection, you must replace the words "time date" with the words "time and date."

Storage & Disposal section comment(s), middle of page 5 of 6:

5. Revise the subsection heading "Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:" to read "Container Disposal:"

To properly facilitate inclusion of required label language from the Agency's guidance "Required Label Language for Indoor Total Release Fogger Products," dated March 23, 2010, and "Update on Required Label Language for Indoor Total Release Fogger Products," dated July 6, 2011, you must include label statements in both English and Spanish. Verify that the Spanish language text is true and accurate translation of the English text, and submit a verification statement to EPA. Include both language versions of the labeling on the product container. In addition, the Agency recommends that MGK Company: (1) Adopt smaller unit sizes (2 oz versus the standard 6 oz), since the subject label lists container sizes ranging from 2 to 6 ounces; (2) Utilize a time-delayed release mechanism (3-5 seconds); and (3) Switch to non-flammable propellants.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.


