- e. Replace the Precautionary Statement section with "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.".
- f. Under Statement of Practical Treatment you may delete the if inhaled section.
- g. Delete "Less spray will be needed than other products that you may be accustomed to using.". Vague or non-specific terms and/or comparative statements implying unstated benefits are not acceptable.
