The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the MGK 264 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

[STOP!] READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE.

Does not control bed bugs.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:

Do not apply this product in a manner that will contact adults, children or pets either directly or through drift. For use only when building has been vacated by human beings and pets.

Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required.

TO USE THIS PRODUCT CORRECTLY:

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. **Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property.** Do not use in a room 5 ft. X 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

BEFORE YOU FOG:

In the home, do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use

Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and ventilation equipment. Put out all flames, pilot lights and other ignition sources. Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance.

Remove pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before activating fogger.
Place a chair, small table or stand in the center of the room to be treated and cover with newspaper

Cover wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area around fogger with newspapers or a drop cloth. Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated

Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours.

SHAKE WELL AND KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT

TO START FOGGING: Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button down firmly, until it snaps into place. [Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up).] Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Keep treated area closed for two (2) hours.

Do not Re-enter for 2 hours



AIRING OUT: Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required

FOR FLEAS AND TICKS: Remove pet bedding before treatment. After treatment, replace pet bedding with new or freshly laundered bedding material. Pets should be treated with a pesticide product registered for use on animals at the same time that the house and yard are treated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Keep container closed. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.
