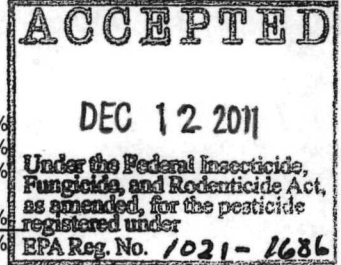

**GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:**

Do not apply this product in a manner that will contact adults, children or pets either directly or through drift.

For use only when building has been vacated by human beings and pets.

Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required.

**To Use This Product Correctly:**

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. **Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property.** Do not use in a room 5 ft. X 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

**Before you Fog:**

In the home, do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 5 representing "Remove or Cover Exposed Food"

Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and ventilation equipment. Put out all flames, pilot lights and other ignition sources. Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance.

Remove pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before activating fogger. Place a chair, small table or stand in the center of the room to be treated and cover with newspaper

Cover wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area around fogger with newspapers or a drop cloth. Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated

Use only one canister of fogger to treat a room up to 16 ft. x 16 ft with an 8 ft. ceiling or 2,000 cubic ft. of unobstructed space. [ 20 ft. x 20 ft. with an 8 ft. ceiling or 3,000 cubic ft. of unobstructed space] [22 ft. x 22 ft. with an 8 ft. ceiling or 4,000 cubic ft. of unobstructed space][ 25 ft. x 25ft. with an 8 ft. ceiling or 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space.][27 ft. x 27 ft. with an 8 ft. ceiling or 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space.]

**SHAKE WELL AND KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT**

**TO START FOGGING:** Immediately before activating fogger complete the door hang tag by filling in the time and date to instruct people not to enter the premises for at least two (2) hours from the activation time. Hang the tag on the door to the entrance.

Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button down firmly, until it snaps into place. [Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up).] Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

**Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately.** Do not remain in the area during treatment. Keep treated area closed for two (2) hours.

**Do not Re-enter for 2 hours**



**Airing Out:** Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required

EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 6 Representing "Air out the Room Before Entering"

**FOR FLEAS AND TICKS:** Remove pet bedding before treatment. After treatment, replace pet bedding with new or freshly laundered bedding material. Pets should be treated with a pesticide product registered for use on animals at the same time that the house and yard are treated.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.
