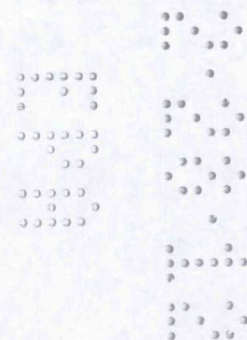

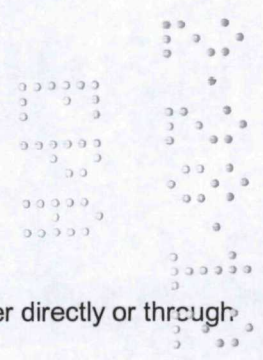

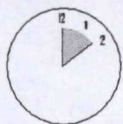
SHAKE WELL AND KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT

TO START FOGGING:

Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button down firmly, until it snaps into place. [Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up).] Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Keep treated area closed for two (2) hours.

Do not Re-enter for 2 hours



Airing Out: Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detectable, additional ventilation is required
