Dear Mr. Ditto:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

General Statement(s):

- 1. Delete all text throughout the subject amended label that is marked with "strike-through."
- 2. The subject amended label currently contains both indoor and outdoor uses. Please note that various label comments have been included within the following label review in response to MGK's recently processed technical outdoor use deletion for MGK 264 insecticide synergist.

Marketing Claims section comment(s):

- 3. Delete the 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th optional marketing claims since various CSFs for this product do contain fragrances.
- 4. Revise the 22nd optional marketing claim to read "[For Indoor & Limited Outdoor Residential Use]."

Precautionary Statements, Environmental Hazards subsection comment(s):

5. To facilitate inclusion of required label changes from the REDs for prallethrin and MGK-264 insecticide synergist, revise "Environmental Hazards" subsection to read:

"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to fish in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements."

Directions for Use section comment(s):

6. To facilitate inclusion of required label changes from the REDs for prallethrin, esfenvalerate, and MGK-264 insecticide synergist, add the following new subsection immediately following the statement "It is a violation of Federal law ..." as follows:

USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- · Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.
- This product is intended for indoor/limited outdoor residential use only.
- All residential outdoor applications must be limited to building surfaces and spot treatments on structures only. Broadcast surface applications are prohibited
- · Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Do not wet articles to the point of run-off or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried.
- Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food processing surfaces, or wash them before use.
- Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.
- Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow this product to enter any drain during or after application.
- · Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
- 7. Revise the subsection heading "General:" to read "Use Information:"
- 8. As a result of the outdoor use deletion for MGK 264 insecticide synergist, you must do the following:
 - Within the 3rd sentence of the 1st paragraph at the top of page 3 of 3, insert the word "interior" immediately preceding the words "elements" and "walls."
 - Within the 2nd and 3rd sentences of the "<u>Flies and Mosquitoes</u>:" subsection, replace the word "spray" with the words "spot treatments."
 - Revise the alternate use directions subsection in the middle of page 3 of 3 to read:

"[READ ALL LABEL DIRECTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE USE. [Product name] is intended to use as a limited exterior spot treatment on residential structures to keep ants from entering the structure. Direct your application to areas that ants and other listed insects use as common entry points into residential structures. This product is especially useful in early spring when ants emerge and attempt to enter the house. Use it again in the fall when ants attempt to come inside for the winter.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS, and always use the attached red extension tube to direct the application. A spare red extension tube is included with each can. For best results, follow directions for specific listed insects and use areas. This product is designed for limited outdoor applications to building surfaces and spot treatments on structures only. Do not apply this product directly to animals. Any liquid may adversely affect some building materials. Always test in an inconspicuous area prior to widespread use.

LIMITED OUTDOOR USE: All residential outdoor applications must be limited to building surfaces and spot treatments on structures only. Spray with caution when wind conditions may create a mist that may blow back to applicator. Always attempt to use the attached red extension tube or spare. When engaged, spray will shoot out a stream 10 to 15 feet long. The liquid will expand upon hitting a target surface, and then leave an invisible residual deposit to kill ants. Do not spray this product in and around bodies of water.

ANTS: Focus your spot treatments to key areas outside the house where you suspect ants are entering the structure, such as around downspouts and gutters, near window sills, and door openings. Seal up any visible exterior cracks where ants can be seen entering the home."

SPIDERS: Focus your spot treatments to spiders and webs on the exterior of building surfaces.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, Crickets, Sowbugs, Multicolored Asian Ladybird Beetles. Focus your spot treatments to key areas outside the house where you suspect these insects are entering the structure, such as around downspouts and gutters, near window sills, and door openings. Spray insects directly where possible. Seal up any visible exterior cracks where crawling insects can be seen entering the home.]"

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Only For Use In and Around Residential Areas Such As Rooms, Apartments, Homes, Attics, Basements, Campers, Boats, Household Storage Areas, Garages, Pet Sleeping Areas, and Cabins.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

<u>General</u>: Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control Asian lady beetles, boxelder bugs, Brown Marmorated stink bugs (BMSB), cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, stink bugs, ticks, waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not allow-shildren or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.
