On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally reregistered in accordance with FIFRA Sec. 3(c)(5) provided that you make the label changes specified below. Once a pesticide is reregistered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. In the ingredient statement, change the name of the active ingredient to read "DEET".

Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eye, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe vapors. Wash hands before eating, drinking chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

Add to the First Aid Statements the following:

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
