DANGER

This product is to be used with appropriate solvents, carriers, and in the case of pressurized products, propellants in the manufacture of insect repellent products that are used on and around humans in indoor and outdoor situations. This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s).

Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies.

Warm contents to room temperature. Mix contents well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feedstuffs by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed. Protect from freezing.
