

3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.



Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a space spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overuse. Frequent reapplication and saturation of clothing are unnecessary for effectiveness. To apply to face, spray palms of hand and apply to cover face. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not spray directly on the face. Also apply to clothing such as shirt, pants, hat, and socks. Do not use under clothing. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs and socks.
