Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label by adding an 8 hour duration claim is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1) The claims, "Repels mosquitoes for 8 hours." and "Provides Up To 8 hours Protection From Mosquitoes." are acceptable.
- 2) The claim, "which may carry diseases such as West Nile Virus, encephalitis and dengue are not acceptable. It must be deleted from the label. This claim must be verified by testing against two vectors of these diseases.
- 3) The claim, "Repels Biting Insects For 8 Hours/Provides Up To 8 Hours Protection.", is not acceptable and must be deleted from the label.
- 4) A 4 hour protection claim for the other pests listed on the label is acceptable.

A stamped copy of the revised draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the corrected finished label before the product is released for shipment under this amended label.

A copy of the Efficacy review is enclosed for your records.
