Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Non-food/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, mop closets and storage (after packaging, canning, or bottling.)"
