  - Relocate the line containing "IF SWALLOWED" to appear as the third line in this section.
  - The statement starting with "Have the product container or..." should be relocated to appear on its own line just before the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" section and should have a similar heading that reads "HOT LINE NUMBER."

d. Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section:

- Delete the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence and replace with "Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing."
- In the 4<sup>th</sup> sentence, replace the word "rubber" with "waterproof."
- In the 5<sup>th</sup> sentence, replace the word "reaction" with the word "reactions."
- In the 6<sup>th</sup> sentence, insert the words "thoroughly with soap and water after handling and" immediately following the word "hands."
- Delete the 7<sup>th</sup> sentence and replace with "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

e. Physical or Chemical Hazards section: Delete the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence and replace with "Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame."

f. Directions for Use section: The 2 bullets listed on the label under this heading may be deleted since this information is already listed in the "Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section.

g. Storage and Disposal:

- Due to the flammability concern of this product, delete the "STORAGE" subsection in its entirety and replace with "Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flames."
- Insert the following text as a new subsection immediately following the "STORAGE" subsection: "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."
- The existing subsection currently listed as "DISPOSAL" should be changed to "CONTAINER DISPOSAL."

3. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if absorbed through skin, swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

**FLAMMABLE.** Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.
- Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

**HOW TO USE:**

Shake container well before use. Point sprayer button at the insects to be sprayed or the surfaces to be treated and press down. Spray surfaces until lightly moist, moving the container to keep from excessively wetting the surface and wasting product. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet either directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. NOTE: Application to plants will cause damage. Rinse accidentally sprayed plants immediately. Do not use as a space spray for flying insects. Cover or remove fish bowls (tanks) before using product. Exposed food should be covered or removed during spraying and food handling surfaces should be washed with soap and water before use. Do not use in serving areas when food is exposed. Entry Restrictions: Do not allow people or pets to enter treated area until the spray has dried.

**CONTROLS:**

**Ants:** Spray directly on ants and ant trails. Follow the trail back to the source of entry into the house, usually a crack or crevice in the flooring or wall, or window or door frame. Repeat treatment when pests noted, but not more frequently than monthly.

**Roaches, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrat, Centipedes, Millipedes, Pillbugs, and Sowbugs:** Spray directly on insects when seen. Spray surfaces under stove, refrigerator, sink, around plumbing, in cabinets, closets, along baseboards and other areas where these insects hide or are suspected. Repeat treatment when pests are seen, but not more frequently than 6 to 8 weeks.

**Carpet Beetles:** Spray directly on beetles or larvae when seen. Spray along baseboards and edges of rugs and carpeting. Spot spray backing of rugs and carpets and allow to dry thoroughly before replacing on floor. Also treat under furniture, in closets (baseboards and shelving), and wherever the larvae are suspected.

**Fleas and ticks:** Spray around pet resting areas, cracks and crevices in flooring and wall/baseboard areas, window and door frames, and other areas where pests are seen. The pet's bedding should be removed and laundered or replaced. Do not treat pet with this product. Use a product labeled for use on animals and treat the outdoor areas used by the pet for complete control.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place, preferably a locked storage area.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not puncture or incinerate!
