Subject: Labeling Amendment; Precautionary Advisory Statements  
Pryocide Pressurized Ant & Roach Spray 70451  
EPA Registration No. 1021-1730  
Submission Date: June 6, 2005

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) Within the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section of the label, after the sentence "Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist", include the sentence "Wear protective clothing and waterproof gloves."
- 2) In a letter dated October 26, 2004, the Agency requested that all residual claims be removed from the label. The claim, "Kills pests after spray has dried" is residual in nature and must be deleted from the label.
- 3) Centipedes are listed on the product label, however no efficacy data has been submitted. Centipedes must be deleted, or have supportive data submitted or cited.
- 4) Immediately after the claim "spiders" include the disclaimer, "excluding black widow and brown recluse spiders". This disclaimer may be removed in the future, upon acceptance of acceptable efficacy data for both.
- 5) Immediately after the claim "ants" include the disclaimer, "excluding fire, harvester, and pharaoh ants". This disclaimer may be removed in the future, upon acceptance of acceptable efficacy data for each.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

**Flammable.** Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product  
 in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**HOW TO USE:**

**SHAKE CONTAINER WELL BEFORE USE.** Point sprayer button at the insects to be sprayed or the surfaces to be treated and press down. Spray surfaces until lightly moist, moving the container to keep from excessively wetting the surface. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. NOTE: Application to plants will cause damage. Rinse accidentally sprayed plants immediately. Do not use as a space spray for flying insects. Cover or remove fish bowls (tanks) before using product. Cover or remove exposed food during spraying and wash food-handling surfaces with soap and water before use following spraying. Do not use in serving areas when food is exposed. Entry Restrictions: Do not allow people or pets to enter treated area until spray is dry.

**CONTROLS:**

Ants: Spray directly on ants and ant trails. Follow the trail back to the source of entry into the house, usually a crack or crevice in the flooring, wall, or window or door frame. Repeat treatment when pests noted, but not more frequently than monthly.

Roaches, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrats, Centipedes, Millipedes, Pillbugs, and Sowbugs: Spray directly on insects when seen. Spray surfaces under

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stove, refrigerator, and sink, around plumbing, in cabinets and closets along baseboards, and other areas where these insects hide or are suspected. Repeat treatment when pests appear, but not more frequently than 6 to 8 weeks.

**Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray beetles or larvae when seen. Spray along baseboards and edges of rugs and carpeting. Spot spray backing of rugs and carpets and allow to dry thoroughly before replacing on floor. Also, treat under furniture, in closets (baseboards and shelving), and wherever larvae are suspected.

**Fleas and Ticks:** Spray around pet resting areas, cracks and crevices in flooring and wall/baseboard areas, window and door frames, and other areas where pests are seen. Remove and launder or replace pet bedding. Do not treat pets with this product. Use a product labeled for use on animals, and treat outdoor areas used by the pet for complete control.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flames.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

### **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:**

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
