Dear Sir or Madam:

By Notification we are changing the storage and disposal language to comply with the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment". We are also adding the marketing claims, "Indoor & Outdoor Use" and "Kills Ants, Roaches, Fleas, Ticks, Spiders, Bedbugs, Clothes Moths, Lice & Their Eggs, Plus Garden and Other Insects (as listed)". There are existing data to support this claim.

Enclosed are 2 copies of the label. One copy has changes highlighted.

Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.144, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist or contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses: Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present onto intertigal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters or rinsate.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Cover or remove fishbowls. This product is not for use on humans.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

For Use in the Non-Food areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, and other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in the edible product areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

Exposed stages of CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, GRANARY WEEVILS, and GRAIN MITES: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets.

BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Allow to dry thoroughly before remaking bed. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before reuse. Do not treat blankets, sheets, pillows, pillow cases, or mattress covers.

To control CLOTHES MOTHS and CARPET BEETLES on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storage areas, directing the spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

TO TREAT LIVESTOCK: To protect beef cattle, dairy cattle, goats, sheep, hogs and horses from attacks of STABLE FLIES, HORSE FLIES, DEER FLIES, FACE FLIES, HOUSE FLIES, HORN FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS. Spray on each side of animal being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from FACE FLIES, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

FOR SWINE: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

To control BLOOD SUCKING LICE: Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control POULTRY LICE, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly, followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

For control of BEDBUGS AND MITES in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS (Adults and Larvae) [ON DOG PREMISES]: Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor, and floor covering with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

Protects Horses and Ponies from attacks of Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Face Flies, Deer Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats. **Do not use on foals under 3 months of age.**

To Protect Horses and Ponies from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats. Spray on each side being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect for Face Flies spray the face and head but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome. **Wipe-On:** Remove excess dust and dirt. Spray product on clean cloth and wipe animal, being careful to treat back, withers, and forelegs. To protect from face flies, apply to face and head but avoid contact with eyes.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE

FOR PETS: USE ONLY ON DOGS, HORSES, AND PONIES

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant, or nursing animals.

To control FLEAS, TICKS AND LICE on dogs: Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted für in short bursts, die ectly behind the hand to ensure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth, or genitalia of pets. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations. NOTE: Do not use on pupples less than 12 weeks old.

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To kill LICE AND LOUSE EGGS: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, and then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use. Do not treat blankets, sheets, pillows, pillow cases, or mattress covers.

For the control of GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill JAPANESE BEETLES hit by spray, as well as WHITEFLIES, APHIDS, EXPOSED THRIPS, SPIDERS, RED MITES AND LEAFMINERS.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatment of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews, and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against WHITEFLIES, APHIDS, SPIDER AND RED MITES, EXPOSED THRIPS, LACE BUGS, JAPANESE BEETLES, PAVEMENT ANTS, CLOVER MITES AND ARMY WORMS. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants, and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatments as infestations occur.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or parks, or lawns and grounds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling

Optional Storage and Disposal Instructions for Agricultural Use:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

Pesticide Disposal

To avoid wastes, use all material in this container by application according to label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to a waste disposal facility or pesticide disposal program (often such programs are run by state or local governments or by industry).

Container Handling

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeatable procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state and local ordinances.

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
