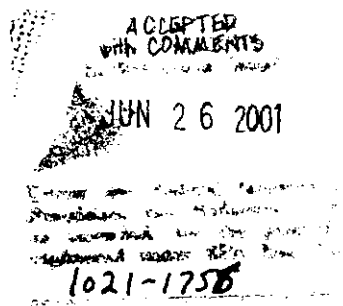

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply to humans, pets, plants or contaminate feed, feedstuffs, dishes or utensils. Cover and avoid spraying fish aquariums. Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, utensils and food handling equipment.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared food is served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Non food areas of restaurants or food handling establishments are areas including (but not limited to) garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE

Hold container upright. Apply only to surface. Do not use as a space spray. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12 to 18 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray surface until wet but not to runoff. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials. More frequent applications will be required to maintain residual control on plywood and other absorbent surfaces.

For Control of Cockroaches and Waterbugs: Spray until wet in cracks around baseboard and other hiding places such as under sinks, behind stoves, refrigerators, plumbing pipes and other areas where these pests are seen. When bugs are driven out spray directly.

For Control of Ants: Apply to ant trails, around doors, windows, and wherever ants enter house.

For Control of Cat Flea, Brown Dog Tick, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Sowbugs, Spiders (including Black Widow), Scorpions and Silverfish: Spray until wet in cracks around baseboard and other hiding places such as under sinks, behind stoves, refrigerators, plumbing pipes and other areas where these pests are seen. When bugs are driven out spray directly.

For Control of Stored Product Pests: (Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles & Rice Weevils). In the home kitchen, remove and inspect stored food products. Remove infested packages and seal in plastic bag to prevent reinfestation. Discard bag in garbage. After removing all food packages and shelf liner, spray visible pests, crack, crevices and corners of pantry, cupboards, and storage areas. Allow treated areas to dry and then put new shelf liner down and return containers to shelves. Repeat treatment as necessary, but not more frequently than once every 2 weeks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area that is cool and dry.

DISPOSAL: Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. The empty container may be placed with other steel cans for recycling, where available. Otherwise, replace cap and discard in trash.
