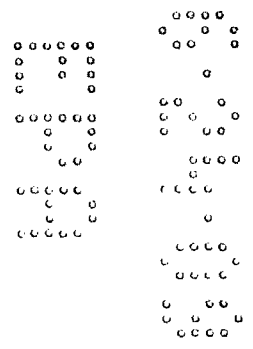

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not apply to humans, pets, or plants or contaminate feed, feedstuffs, dishes, or utensils. Cover and avoid spraying fish aquariums. Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, utensils, and food handling equipment.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments or restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared food is served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Non-food areas of restaurants or food handling establishments are areas including (but not limited to) garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE

Hold container upright. Apply only to surface. Do not use as a space spray. Hold about 12 to 18 inches from surface being sprayed. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Spray surface until wet but not to the point of runoff. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber, and plastic materials. More frequent applications will be required to maintain residual control on plywood and other absorbent surfaces.

For Control of Cockroaches and Waterbugs: Spray in cracks and around baseboards and other hiding places such as under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, around plumbing pipes, and in other areas where these pests are seen until surface is wet. Directly spray bugs when flushed out.

For Control of Ants: Apply to ant trails, around doors, windows, and wherever ants enter house.

For Control of Cat Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Sowbugs, Spiders (including Black Widow), Scorpions, and Silverfish: Spray in cracks and around baseboards and other hiding places such as under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, around plumbing pipes, and in other areas where these pests are seen until surface is wet. Directly spray bugs when flushed out.

For Control of Stored Product Pests: (Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, and Rice Weevils). In the home kitchen, remove and inspect stored food products. Remove infested packages and seal in plastic bags to prevent reinfestation. Discard bags in garbage. After removing all food packages and shelf liners, spray visible pests and cracks, crevices, corners of pantries, cupboards, and storage areas. Allow treated areas to dry. Then install new shelf liner and return containers to shelves. Repeat treatment as necessary but not more frequently than once every 2 weeks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Pesticide Storage Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area that is cool and dry. Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

If empty:

Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
