After removing all food packages and shelf liner, spray visible pests and cracks, crevices, and corners of pantries, cupboards, and storage areas. Allow treated areas to dry and then install new shelf liner and return containers to shelves. Repeat treatment as necessary, but not more frequently than once every 2 weeks.
