DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing auriaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. Food processing operations do not have to be stopped while applying a wet spray with care and in accordance with the directions and cautions above in those establishments that do NOT operate under Federal meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg products inspection programs.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

<u>GENERAL</u>: This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers that create particles of aerosol size. It can be diluted with refined kerosenes that meet Food Additive Regulations 21 CFR 172.884 and can be applied in fogging equipment that gives larger-than-aerosol-size particles. It can also be diluted with oil specified above and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown later on this label.

SPACE SPRAY:

<u>UNDILUTED IN AEROSOL GENERATORS - TO KILL FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS</u>: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 1 fluid ounce of undiluted concentrate per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards ceiling and upper corners of room. Leave room closed for one half hour (30 minutes). Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

CONTACT SPRAY:

DILUTED FOR USE WITH SPRAYERS THAT GIVE LARGE, WETTING SPRAY PARTICLES TO KILL COCKROACHES AND ACCESSIBLE STAGES OF GRANARY INSECTS, CADELLES, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, GRAIN MITES, GRANARY WEEVILS, MEAL MOTH LARVAE AND ADULTS, RED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, AND SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Cover or remove exposed food and close room as described

above. Dilute concent with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 20 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside with figrain bins, flooring about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harborages, using 1 gallon of spray per 1,000 cubic feet of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary.

<u>NOTE</u>: When diluted properly as described and applied per the directions and cautions given above, this spray conforms to Food Additive Regulation 21 CFR 172.884 and the food additive tolerances established thereunder.

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
