By notification we are revising the active ingredient name of this product from the chemical name to the common name, d-Phenothrin. We are enclosing two (2) copies of the label with the changes highlighted on one of the labels. We are also enclosing a copy of the Confidential Statement of Formula with the addition of the common name.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 97-5 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand this is a violation of 18 U.S.C. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA.
